**Finance Committee Report to Parish for fiscal year from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 (2019-2020):** Thank you to all who supported St. Joseph the Worker parish this last fiscal year in prayer and through your generous offerings. People are giving at Holy Mass in the collection, dropping by the office with donations, mailing in their gifts and giving online.

St. Joseph the Worker is in a sound financial position and the parish holds no debt. However, we must cover our recurring expenses and financially support future improvements.

At the close of 2019-2020, \$158,961 was held in the Building/Capital Fund account and \$195,961 in Home Campaign/Education Bldg Savings account. In addition, the checking account balance at fiscal year-end was \$77,053.

St. Joseph the Worker revenue, including special collections that are passed on to the diocese or distributed to other charities like Good Shepherd, for 2019-2020 was \$269,041, a 4.1% decrease in revenue compared to the prior year. Total expenses, including special collection money sent to the diocese or distributed to other charities and thus not budgeted, for 2019-2020 were \$255,056, a 6.9% decrease in expenses compared to 2018-2019.

The Finance Committee met with Fr. Abuh on Thursday, June 18 to approve the budget for FY 2020-2021. The parish council met and approved the budget on June 23.

While many faithful parishioners continue to contribute as they are able, we anticipate that 2020-2021 will be a challenging year financially. As you can see from recent bulletins our contributions at this time are not sufficient to support our budget. We are continually looking at ways to reduce expenses and are having some success with that. Your continued support is greatly needed to support the parish especially during these challenging times.
