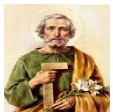
Because of safety reasons due to COVID-19, the Good Shepherd Center has cancelled their Annual Fund Raiser for this year. Starting this month, they will be doing a direct mail solicitation to every household and business in Monroe County as well as surrounding areas. Demand at the Center has increased. Many new families are now needing assistance. Currently, the Center serves an average of 1,500 people/month and distributes approximately 50 boxes of food per day or 30,00 lbs. of food /month at no charge. With the increasing need, the success of the fund raiser is critical. People can make a one-time donation or a pledge over time: monthly, quarterly or semi-annually. Any level of donation would be appreciated. Contributions are tax deductible. The Center is a 501(c)3 organization.
