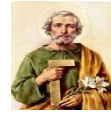
SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

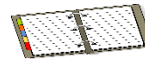

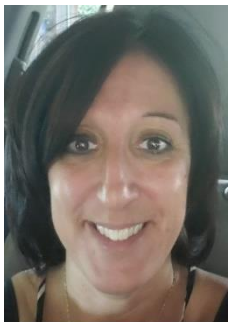
Any parishioner who is sick or having surgery, notify Fr. Julius or the office (privacy is extended to those who request it).
